ICELANDERS THEN & NOW – DYNAMIC CHANGE

ICELANDERS THEN: Experts Jonas Thor, Bruce Crawford, Edith Smith, Guy Scott and J. Marshall Burgess will bring us fascinating details on settlements in Washington Island, Hekkla, Kinmount and Markland/Lockeport. Don Gislason and John Thordarson will take you on a tour of Icelandic Toronto in 1874.

Genealogical specialist George Freeman will present Icelandic genealogy.

Brian Johannesson will tell us the story of his ancestor and the Falcon's Gold Hockey experience followed by an optional extra tour of the Hockey Hall of Fame.

ICELANDERS NOW: Noted leaders Oskar Sigvaldason, Fridrik Jonsson, Jon Johnson and Joe Martin will up-date us on global leadership in energy and new carbon recycling technology in Iceland as well as the details of the financial meltdown and what it has meant. Selections include: orange, apple and grapefruit juice, freshly baked fruit and chocolate filled breakfast pastries, crispy maple cured bacon, breakfast sausage, scrambled eggs with aged cheddar, crispy seasoned home fries, mixed field greens with roast onion vinaigrette, romaine hearts with croutons, bacon bits and caesar dressing, chick pea and tomato cilantro salad, marinated mushroom salad, roast turkey breast with cranberry compote, roast striploin of Alberta beef, fusilli with spinach and sun-dried tomato in a roasted garlic olive oil, assorted tortes, fruit pies and gourmet squares and selection of seasonal sliced melon and berries.
