The applicant or applicant's family must be a member in good standing of the Icelandic Canadian Club of Toronto. Applicants must plan to be involved in the Club; preference will be given to those with current involvement in the ICCT. Grants will be presented at Thorablót on Saturday, March 29, 2008.
